PAU invites applications for crop production training course

Singh said those interested could also submit their applications by visiting the Skill Development Centre, PAU on working days from Monday to Friday from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm. The last date for the receipt of applications is July 29.

The interviews to select candidates for the course will be conducted on July 30 at Skill Development Centre at 10.00 am, he said.

In view of COVID-19 pandemic, all safety measures will be followed during the interview, he informed. The candidates must bring their Class X and proof of age certificates along with them.

The selected candidates will have to deposit Rs 1,000 as security, which will be refunded to only those candidates who complete their course successfully. The course fee is Rs 500 while the accommodation charges are Rs 300 per month.
